# a visitors' guide to bondi

## (Or Harris' Bondi Haunts...)

**Y**es, there is life in the sunny beach suburb of Bondi after the Bondi Hotel closes at 4am (or 6am) in the morning. Try exploring one of our most famous beach suburbs by daylight...

**OK. First up:**

### FOOD YUM SCOFF

Be sure to check out the **North Bondi RSL** on a Monday night. They offer basic food at a low price. The Chicken Maryland is a fave and they run current movies at no charge. Nice one!

For a tasty, cheap and healthy take-away don't miss the roast potatoes - with your choice of assorted toppings - from the pizza place. I don't know the exact address or even the name of this particular store (*oh, good - ed*), but it's one block south of the **Bondi Hotel** (you know the one) on Campbell Parade, in that little open area where the seats are. There's a fruit juice bar on one corner and a fast food take-away on the other. I hope you can find it from my directions... (*yes, enough already!*)

For something a touch more upmarket (what's that??), try the **Lamrock Cafe** (I know it's address), on the corner of Lamrock Avenue and Campbell Parade (*that was difficult*). They have a massive selection of pastas, burgers, focaccia, etc. All are great but you must try the warm Chicken Salad - it's not quite like anything else and it's delicious.

For the vegetarians there's **Cafe Hungaria** in Hall St. This one isn't too expensive and it's clean and not too bright and they have the best coffee in the area. Their desserts have to be eaten to be believed. Try the Mushroom Goulash or the Langos (house speciality) when you're feeling peckish (ie. not on a Monday morning).

**Old Castle...** legendary. They have pizza with a difference and a very lush Pule Farce (*say that in English...*). There are plenty of other cafes facing the beach - use your imagination and let your stomach do the choosing.

Last but not least there's **Yahabibis**. It's yet another Lebanese restaurant, also on Campbell Parade (where

else?). The food is pretty standard but they have quite a few small back rooms which are great for those discrete private gatherings...

### THE SIGHTS

Go and check out the rock pools at the northern end of **Bondi Beach**. Give yourself a good hour or two and be adventurous - there are some amazing rock faces to experience if you go far enough around the point, but be sure to go at low tide or you could have a nasty encounter with a lot of wet stuff (water).

Take a walk from the Southern end of Bondi Beach around to **Tamarama**. When you get to the point - if you're feeling very daring - try the death defying feat of sitting on the edge of the cliff face on the southern side. If you actually sit right on the edge you can lean over the cliff and be held there by the strong sea breeze that comes in off the sea and up the cliff face. It's invigorating!

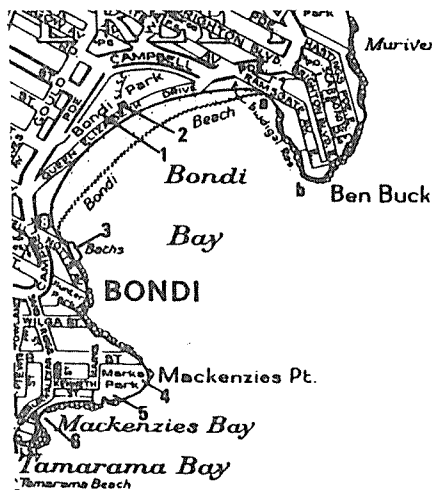
Next time you're passing **The Pavillion** and have a few moments to spare (in the daytime that is) try venturing in. There's fascinating old Bondi photos

and memorabilia - and the odd flashback for those who've had the occasional messy encounter down there.

Finally, but of course most importantly:

### BOOZE ALCOHOL DRINKS

Go and meet the lovely lady at the Cock 'n' Bull drive-thru (in Bondi Junction). She's always delightful and so are the prices. Then take your poison and head towards the beach - but be discreet, the local constabulary have been known to be a little offended when alcohol is found being consumed with a view. If you like to mix your drinks and pool there's free pool every Tuesday night at the **Nelson Hotel** (at the Western end of Oxford St in Bondi Junction). And just before I go - I do believe the current Thursday night attraction consists of a pub crawl through Bondi Junction following the **Happy Hour** specials. Best if you don't have to work on Fridays!
