What a stupid question. A Caravan.

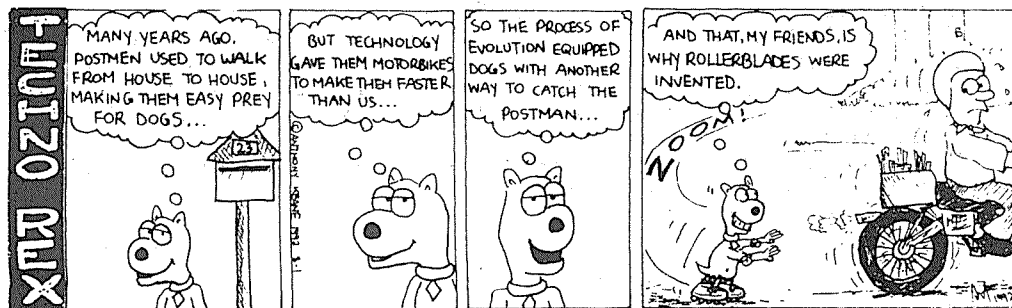

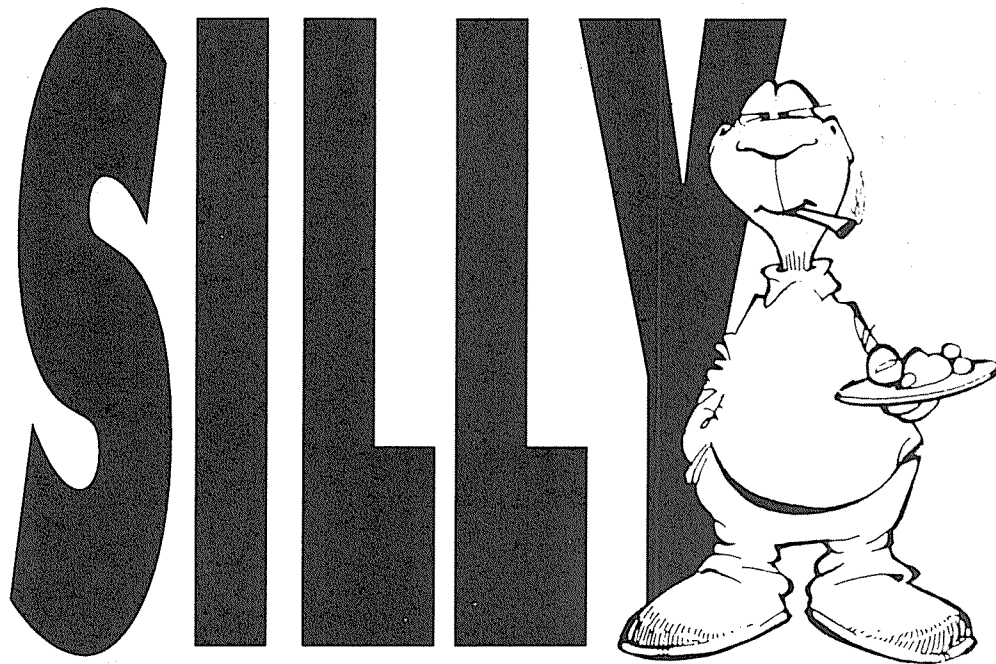
Due to popular demand Hallelujah brings you:

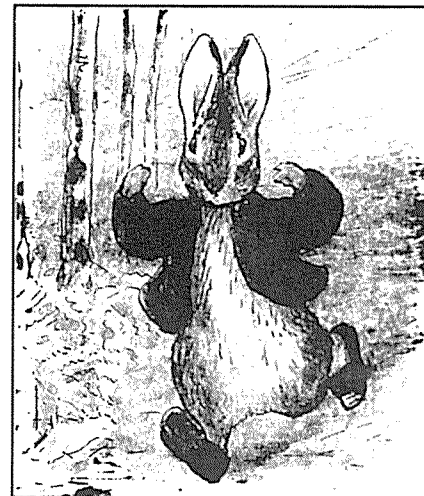

SPECIES NAME: Debby Bunny

COMMON NAMES: David Brace, Bracie, DB. This last name has been the subject of much speculation. Scientists have come up with a number of theories including DeciBel, Dodgy Bastard, Dancing Bullet, Daft Bugger, Disco Biscuit...

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES: Immaculate flat top hairstyle (hence the expression "David Brace not a hair out of place"), abundance of rave-credible label clothing, portable phone, huge jackets with loads of pockets, at least one record box, and most importantly large, bouncy trainers in a rainbow of colours. When trying to locate the Debster look for it's common companion the Tony Pony or simply follow the trail of flyers. It can be spotted jumping about with the herd at major events, it's nose twitching happily.

This is very DJ friendly with nice long breaks and intros, and loads of room in which to drop clever little samples if your that way inclined. Quality mix track but nothing earth shattering. *Hallelujah* staff prefer the Euphoria vs Ernie & Bert's Travelling at the Speed of Sound mix.

I'm Gonna Get You Bizarre Inc featuring Angle Brown Vinyl Solution

Huh. Bizarre Inc. Didn't they do that stormin' techno classic, wot's it called, Playing With Knives? Huh. This'll be well 'ard then. Wrong wrong wrong. Do not pass go and don't even think about \$200. Do these lads know something we don't?

While every other record ais trancebeat with a compulsory tribal sample BI have gone for a happy house track. Original flavour mix features catchy female vocals, Todd's Rubber Dub has loads of nothing (in true dub tradition). Thank god for the Sure Is Pure Golden Dub - loads of brilliant FX over a driving percussive beat. Pity it's an edit and therefore too short... oh well...

Free Wolfman Spilsh

Screaming female vocals, kickin' rhythm, Italopiano and soothing trancey chords all combine to create a deep fave for the discerning trance addict. A definite 5 O'clocker. Check out the guitar interface mix.

Metropolis Evolution Positive Vinyl

One of those rare as fuck records that can be currently picked up in a few select record stores due to some serious network-

ing by one clever (astral) traveller. This is some of Sasha's earlier remixing work and as usual he comes through with the goods. Leads one to wonder if Evolution ever shared a room with Acorn Arts. Worth the money.

Take It Alex Lee React

Did someone say "Progressive House?" This song combines smooth soul with trance (if that can be done) at about 124 bpm. Cruises along nicely, highly recommended for that 7am feeling we've all come to know and love. Nuff said. (Sorry Ray that's your line, isn't it?)

Don't Look Down C- Force Better Days

Funky uptempo track with honky-tonk piano and a sample cheekily stolen from Earth Wind & Fire's System Of Survival. Makes for a perfect club track - now all we need is a decent club to play it at. Well worth checking out.

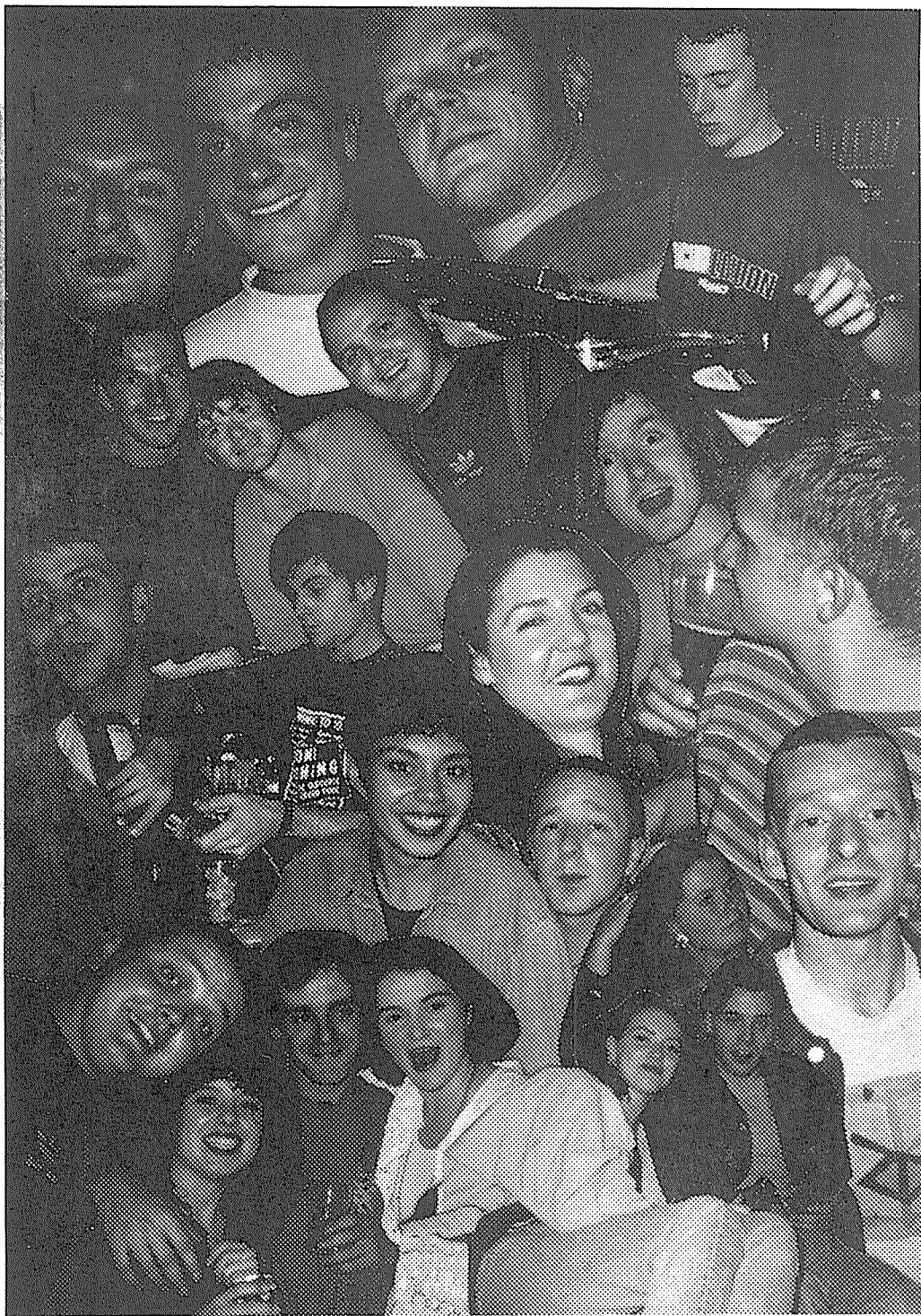
