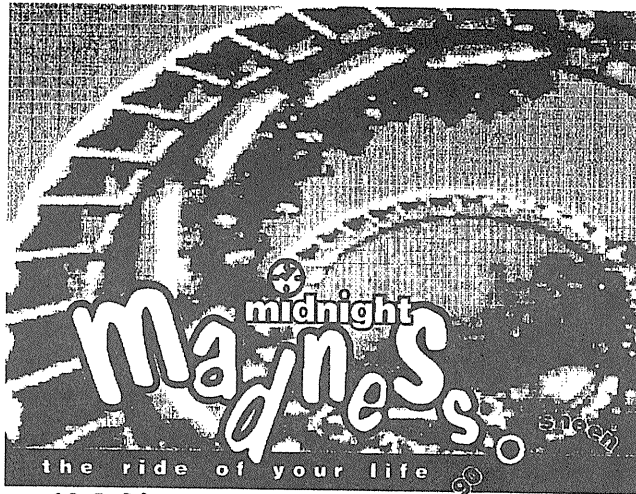

'Orright' - 'Hello, how are you?'

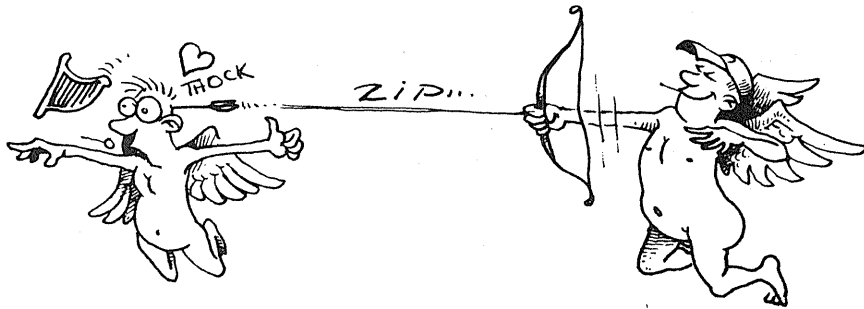
'Orright Darlin' - as above to a female

has that potential. Or is it past its 'use by' date? Up there, out there and all the rest. Grab a copy and enjoy the trip.

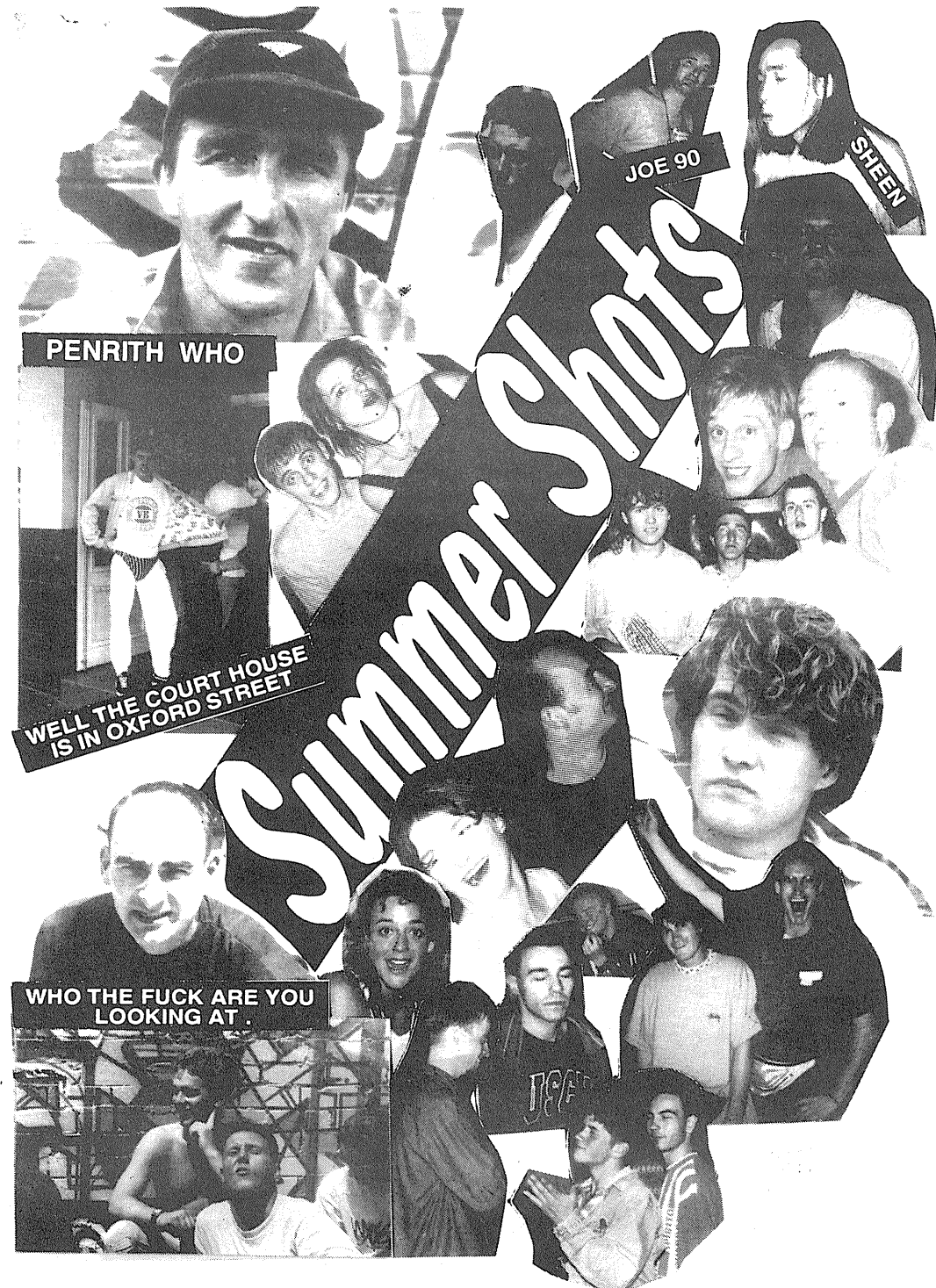
Love Decade 'So Real'
