## FLAMMABLE



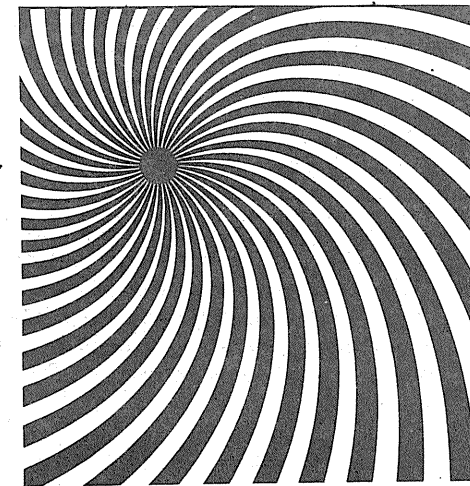

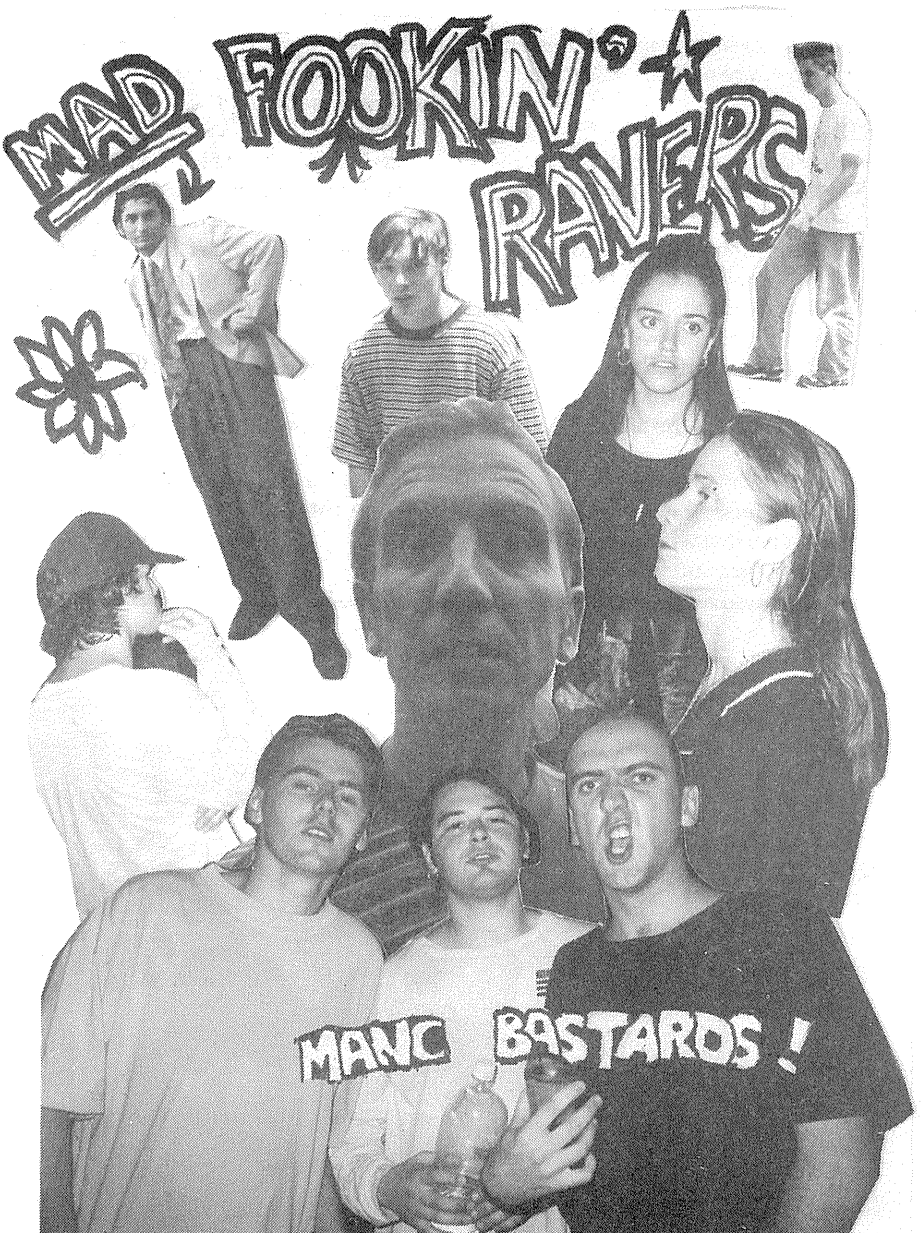

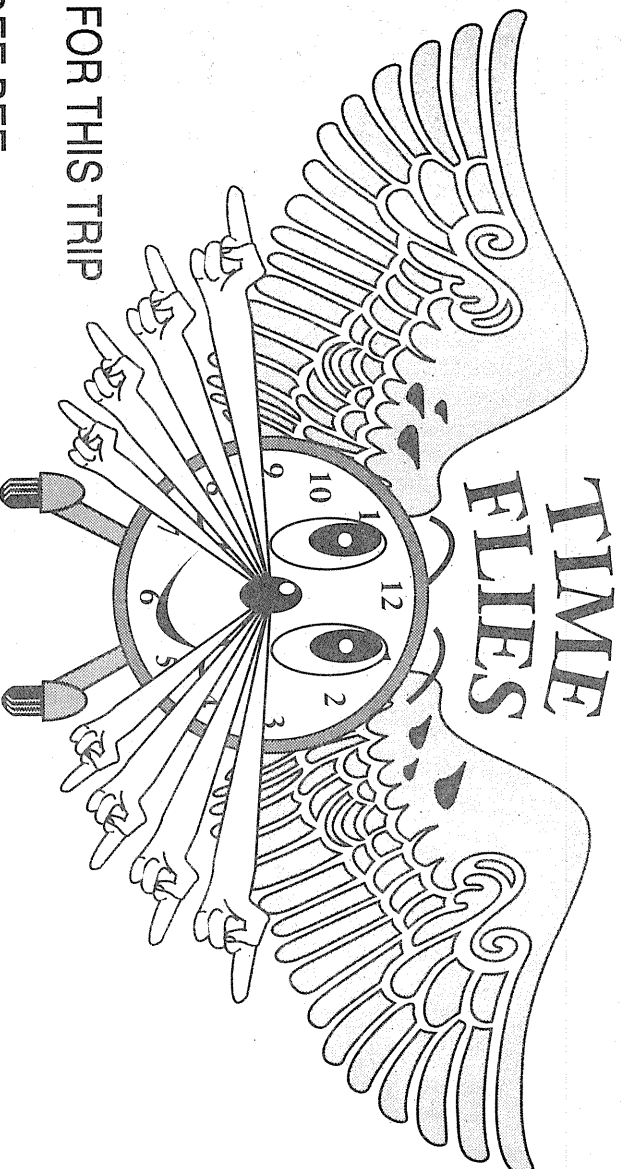
