What to ask them (so you can figure out if their accents are real)

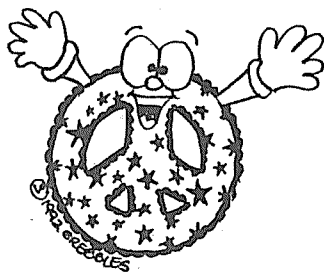
1. **Where do you come from?** Determines the all important question of whether they're from the South or Up North
