Ravers can not live on McDonalds alone!

There are alternatives that aren't fast food, not necessarily Healthy, but appelling and in a Rave Safe environment to suit most of our species. In other words - cheap! With a menu to suit younger tastes and most of all - why the fuck should you go there.

Well "Deans" Cafe in the Cross is the Perfect Pre-Rave spot (chill and stuff your face!).

The Decor is something of a cross between Hippy Heaven, Rasta and Grandma's place with enough waxlights, ornaments and antique crap from the 60's and 70's to keep even the most hardcore amused.

Walk in and, if you're lucky enough to land on one, there are some large sofa's with cushions (that smell very familiar) to sprawl on and a fire place thats usually burning in these cold months.

Service is a bit slow but someone will stick a menu in your face eventually, the printing is a bit small but if bring the menu up to your nose you should be able to read it.

Most things are vegetarian here but before you turn up your nose and say "where's the beef" the nachos here is "massive", you could call it hardcore! At \$11.50 it could feed up to 4 people or if you're hardcore, you could go the whole thing yourself. 18 inches wide and about 18 inches high - with enough sour cream and melted cheese to ski on and for an extra \$1.50 you can get avocado and tomato on top.

For those with a job, try the Homous and Babaganaj side salad at \$8.50 - if you're after something sweet and warm, try your loved one or try the sticky toffee pudding - no smaller than a dj's ego.

Coffee prices range from \$2.50 to \$3.50 food from \$4.00 to \$11.50.

Horlicks is available aswell for those who change their mind and decide to go to bed - sleep!

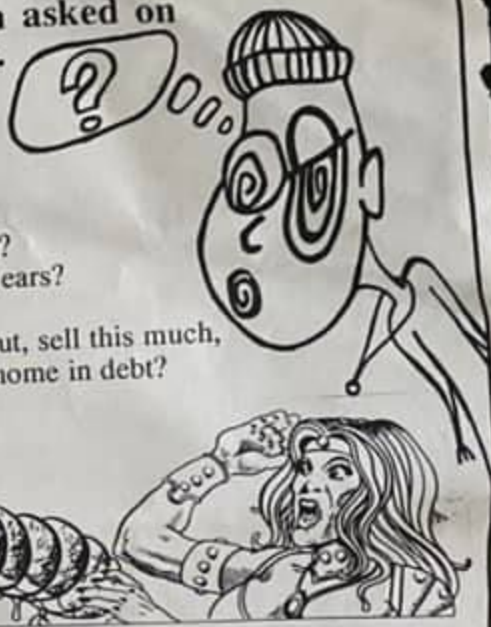
