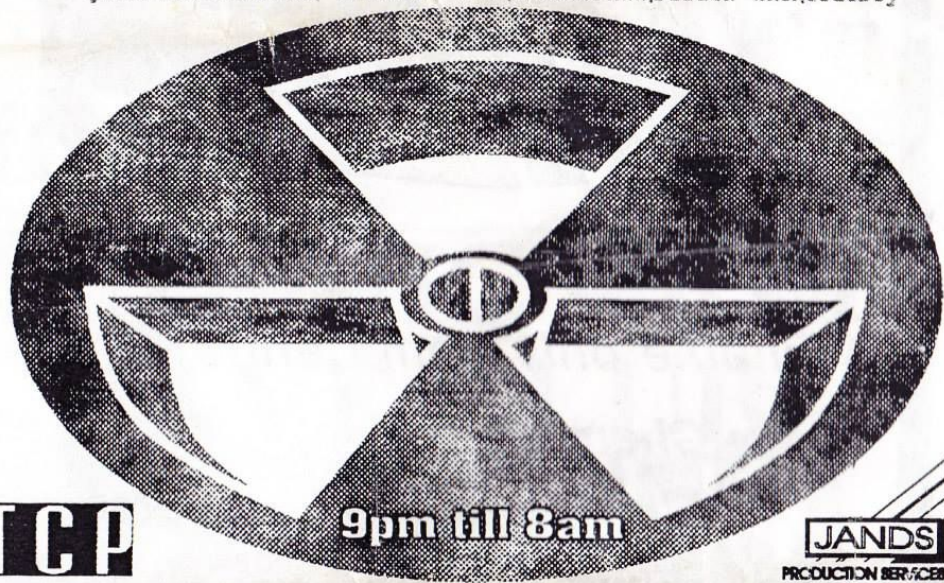

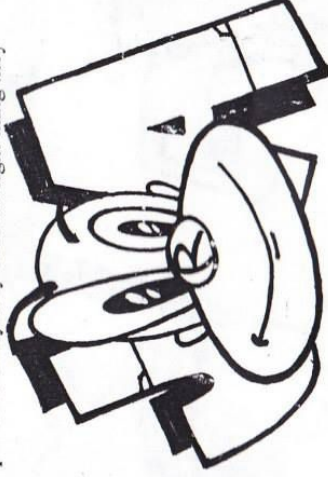
editors note

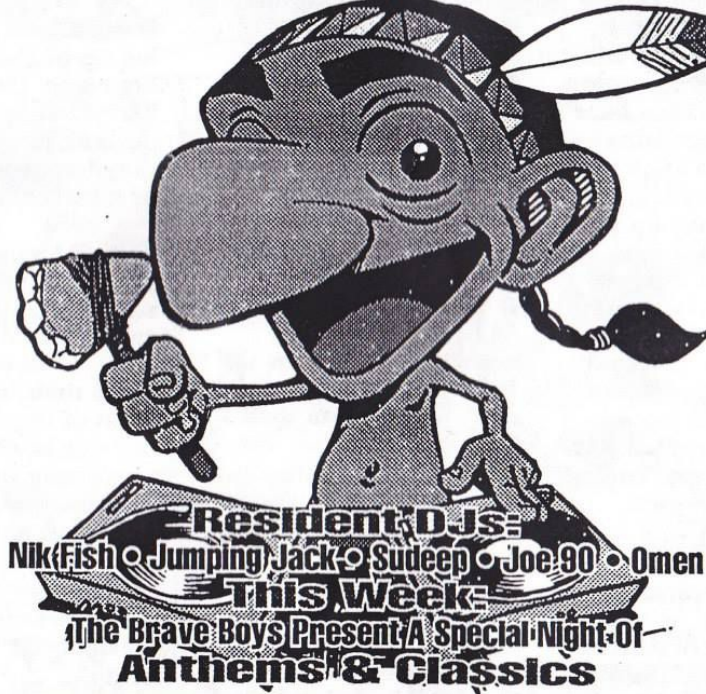

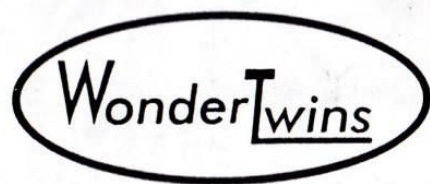

A mate of mine is going OS in a week or so and I want to a North Shore club to see him off (Steps - Cremorne). I don't like this place, No 1-Shitty music, No 2-It's full of young heroes who have to prove how tough they are. At about 2am I was actually having a good time but I started feeling seedy, too many nights out in a row and a fair few beers (I'm off the other stuff), I sat down on the floor due to lack of seating, a couple of minutes later one or more of our young heroes either kicked or punched me in the jaw and knocked me out cold, then stomped on my left wrist and broke it. Over a few hours prior to this there were at least two violent fights. This is a trendy legal venue and so much violence goes unchecked, I have never seen this shit at a rave so why are they illegal?

Thanks to this I cannot go to work now for at least 6 weeks, I will have to go on sickness benefit, I'm sure the prick who did this to me will go free. I was actually thrown out of this dive for causing trouble. I do not fight, I am a most passive loving person, and probably will get no compensation. Anyway, catch my drift?
