Profile

At the ripe old age of 22 DJ Shade has played at various raves, clubs and private parties around Sydney and Newcastle and has just won the SUNDAZE DJ COMPETITION, the DJ comp that has been going for guite some time and if you hadn't heard about it you must be blind, deaf and dumb....... DJ Shade shone through as the winner at the Finals on Sunday 6th August. Shade started DJing in 1989 in Newcastle he was inspired to launch himself in a DJ career because of his love for music, which at the time was Hip Hop and House. His influence started with Hip Hop and the ever popular DMC Comps, as he began on his guest to become a top DJ he got involved in trick mixing like cutting and scratching and found himself eager to get better and better through his mixing ability, and like all DJ's starting out he had his influences, KC (DMC Mixing Champ '93/'94), DJ Alladin (USA), who he admired for their technical style. He started playing in Newcastle as a resident at The Castle Club, and eventually gained more residencies at other clubs in his home town.

Shade hasn't always played techno though, early in his career he played R&B, Trance, Hip House, Rap and Commercial these days he's playing Hi-Energy, Happy Hard,

House and Hardcore

After living and DJing in Newcastle he moved to Sydney in 1994 to try to get more work in the Rave and Club scene, people had told him there was much more work in Sydney for a talented DJ, also there's not much of a rave scene in Newcastle, so because there is an obvious market for Dance and Techno in Sydney he decided to take the plunge and try his luck in the Sydney Rave Scene.

Shades thoughts on the music being played recently in the rave scene are that there aren't enough different styles being played, and that certain styles are not being played at the

right times at the parties, this is something he likes to concentrate on when he plays


buy them on vinyl, and lets face it, who even owns a turntable anymore, unless of course you're a DJ.


