



## **AUSTRALIAN GABBERZ UNITED**

The Australian Force in Hardcore

Australian
Gabberz
United is the
result of three
Sydney DJ's
trying to push a
style that for so
long has not
been truly recognised here in
Australia - Hardcore.

AGU is made up of DJ's Geoff Da Chef, DJ Chuck and Tymez II each playing their own style of hardcore or gabber if you prefer. Since hardcore has come along way since it's startings there are so many different styles that we now call hardcore and according to AGU they each represent an individual sound of their own described as party gabber, gabber, hardcore and industrial gabber although each can cross over and merge into one or the others styles.

AGU was first used as a production name for their first party - Skool of Hardknox, back in November 1995 were Sydney experienced the first 'hard' party probably since the 'Children Of The Hardcore' events. Although it wasn't hardcore (as in gabber) all night. It represented the harder edge of techno where DJ's who played other styles for example jungle or acid could play their harder edged tunes with ease. Something that can't be done when playing their regular events.

Now they are preparing themselves for their next event - 'The Second Semester' - Hardknox 2. You'll either be reading this after you've bought your ticket on Saturday afternoon or while sitting down in the morning because you can't keep up with the pace at 6am. Whatever the reason if you go you will enjoy.

Holland etc, it received write ups in overseas mags and was credited well. This in turn led these three to start producing gabber amongst themselves and before long you will hear of something they have done or are in the process of doing.

But it seems that vinyl is not Sydneys answer to recognition as earlier this year each member traded tapes with hardcore DJ's in the states - the likes of Delta9, Ron D Core and Omar Santana to name a few and now the first AGU tape is on it's way 'A Night in the Study.' A double tape 180 minutes in length with each of them doing a side leaving a side left for the three of them on 3 decks and two mixes - something they base their act on.



Individually - Geoff Da Chef started DJ'ing in 1988 playing commercial club, house, acid, acid house, hip hop and independant and has worked with bands Steam Roadshow and Fleshworld. Progressing on from clubs he favoured harder edged techno and developed a style which drove him out of clubs and into a scene which accepted a more diverse sound.

Dj Chuck got sick of listening to other DJ's play and decided to purchase turntables and spent a lot of time in front of them. He has so far released two tapes one with Da Chef and the other with Tymez II, the third is on it's way and the fourth is a three part series called 'The Hardknox Sessions.'

Tymez II met up with these two one messy Sunday afternoon mid 1995 and within two weeks was addicted. He is now involved in programming his own tracks and is also managing Sydney's hardest store BPM Records.

AGU has performed a number of events so far and will be playing at many more to come. If you haven't yet seen this act or have never really been into hardcore they have a final message for you - 'SOFTIES NEED NOT APPLY'

#### fOd4

The continued hype and build up towards Field of Dreams 4 seemed to add to the certainty that the weekend of July 6th and 7th would be one to remem-

ber. Factors such as an hours drive and a predicted temperature of -3 degrees faded in comparison to the expectations held by the thousands of ticket holders.

The advertising and dream guide had continued to motivate people for months. Much planning and last minute organising saw the majority of us ready for not just a party but a weekend away, which promised to meet all of those expectations. Never before had such a diverse group of party people come together to celebrate dance music on such a scale.

As the world slept the Scout Park came to life. Thousands scattered about this alternative world beneath the stars, seeking a niche in one of the many arenas. The FLC tent literally spilled over through the night. Spellbound, Chester, Akira, Sub Zero, Jim Jams, Chozie, Herb, Chuck, Tymez II and others kept the energy levels high and the temperature and atmosphere soared as hundreds found this style to their liking. Next door Q-Tek, Dawso, Mandrake, Arthur, Attila and the rest of the talented clan catered to those in need of the classics. Smooth and groovy tunes flowed all night and well into the sunrise. Not detracting from these minority arenas. the pure white warehouse stood alone, attracting people with its monstrous appearance and sound. It filled the night air with an indescribable presence as thousands filled it with theirs. All tastes and desires were catered to within those four white walls. Sugar Ray, Jumpin' Jack and others all provided the prelude to Paul Holdens climatic 2am set. Oracles laser display exceeded all expectations, combined with inspiring sets from Abel, Dynamix, Live Act Infusion and Peter Tribe it kept the night sky and the crowd illuminated! As the sun spread its warmth and changed the landscape completely the final sets were played inside the temporary warehouse. Peter Tribe spread his warmth with the sun. The mood changed but the crowds enthusiasm didn't. Thousands still danced as Paul Holden finished it off with his now famous and much anticipated Field of Dreams anthem set. As with every aspect of this event, there were no disappointments. Finally all converged

on the centre of the party and individ-

ual tastes were put aside as each and every person celebrated one thing, music. Outside in the morning sun who else but Jade was there to provide the tunes everyone needed to hear. Leaving the park seemed to be the hardest thing for everyone to do.

#### **FREE LOVE '96**

Hot on the heels of FOD 4 was Bizerk Productions Free Love '96. We were promised so much in the lead up to this event, and the question on everyones lips was how could all this be delivered for free? For starters we were able to see at least 20 of Sydneys best DJ's, and two live acts. BLM dazzled with their sound and lighting, as usual, and the ACME laser display enter-

the ACME laser display entertained and lit up faces all night! The vivacious and always energetic Tutti Frutti dancers even made an appearance, only adding to the atmosphere. I was constant-

It seems we just can't get enough of those Escape recoveries. I wonder exactly what it is that were trying to escape from? Or are




Spellbound, Chester, Akira, Revolution and Pillwa. We're there to keep the choons chunky and alive. Gee Wiz even lent a hand this time!

#### DJ TREVOR -LIVE MIXES

DJ Trevor of Dyewitness fame is captured live in the mix on his Australian Tour this year in April for 'The Brain" with D.J. Nightraver. opens with "The Last Anthem" by Casio Bros. yet another of D.

Trevor's credits. From there it escalates and he blends popular tunes in his typical style with some not so familiar tracks, which breaks the monotany. The mix continues at a fast pace for almost 70 minutes unitl he winds it down with some trance, including that oh-so-popular 'Noom 13"! This "raw mix shows Trevor's skill on the decks as well as in the studio.



#### **RAVE TRAXX VOL 1**

This selection of tracks is gite a mixture as far as style is concerned. The first half of the CD fits neatly in the Happy Hard/Breakbeat categories. However, the individual tracks are not too well known, quite a few are

actually unfamiliar. Towards the end of the CD some good acid sounds emerge from a selection of Hard Trance tracks. The fact that th CD is not beat mixed however detracts from some otherwise interesting music. What confuses me is the fact that these tracks are labelled "All time party athems". Perhaps they're future anthems?

Sugar Ray displays the sheer talent that has made him one of the world's most popular dj's. Phil Smart combines extensive experience both in Aistralia and throughout the world to present his own unmistakable blend of house tunes. Not only are the sounds of Sabotage captured here, so too is the pure energy and unique spirit. unique spirit.



#### DJ NIGHTRAVER -LIVE MIXES

Also recorded here in Australia this year, DJ Nightraver, the other half of Dyewitness, This is a 65 minute Studio mix combining some new material with alot of Happy Hard

Classics. Remember Charlie & Theo "Live at London". Lots of the tracks such as "The Future" capture the sheer energy of their famous live act. It's easy to hear why Nightraver and Trevor work so well together, as di's, as producers and as live performers.



#### DJ POPEYE -THIS IS JUNGLE

"This is Jungle" is a goodintroduction to those unfamiliar with his style. Popeve blends a selection of dark breakbeat and jungle to create an interesting mix which is quite ambient in

nature. This style provides an alternative to the most popular and often played styles of Happy Hard and Hi-energy. Certainly a change of pace, much more relaxing, and mind bending!



#### SPELLBOUND 10

What an achievement! ten tapes in 3 years. Each one fresh and packed full of those tunes which epitomise the style of the time. Spellbound's mixing has reached the point of no return, he is up there with th best! His own unique style works well with tracks

he selects for this recording. It shows just why he fills the dancefloor every Friday night at The Breakfast Club and at all of Sydney's major rave events. It Also gives you a taste of his talents as producer. The first track on Side B he wrote Mikey and MC Bee from Ultimate Buzz when they toured Australia late last year.



Friday 30th is "Rewind" (Anthems '88-'92) with Darren James, Barking Boy and Ken Jensen. A new monthly thing (I think) is 'Energy' with DJ's Nik Fish, Ken Jenson, Dynamix and Jumpin' Jack. Same deal as the Sydney one featuring the sounds of Hard House and Nu NRG. Catch this at the Tube.

DJ Misjah (Dyewitness) appeared at the Roxy some weeks back. The yearly exhibition holidays Rave event 'Blackout' returnes on August 10 at a new venue called The Roxy. 'Creation' on August 31 in the same venue.

On a larger scale of things in Brisbane is 'Digital Overdose' on September 27 featuring DJ's Buzz Fuzz, Gizmo, Dano and Lady Dames. The event will be spread over 2 rooms. 1. "Hellraizer" which will be the Hardcore room. Word from Dano is that he will be goin' HARD!! While the second room "Immortality" will be trance. This event will visit a few Australian cities but Sydney is yet to be confirmed.

'Digital Overdose '96' Part 2 in Amsterdam on August 13 will feature an incredible line up in the Hellraiser room with the likes of Lenny Dee, Dano, PCP, DJ Squad, Manu Le Malin, Omar Santana, Rob, Buzz Fuzz and Live acts PCP (The Ultimate), Leviathan, Future Shock. Immortality will feature Dj's Billy Nasty and Darren Emerson to name a few.

October 5 will see the opening of the new ID&T club "MYSTERYWORLD".

"ADRENALIN" is another big one hitting
Sydney on October 5. Expect to hear Gabber
from DJ Clarke. This guy's been around for a
long fucking time.

Jan 27, Australia Day long weekend is THUN-DERDOME '97. This is the REAL ID&T event! Wait till you see the line up!! This mega event

is planned for Sydney only.

Due to the announcement that DJ Paul will be touring in October Rob Gee's tour has been postponed, October 28 is the date locked in for Sydney.

On the production side.....DJ Beats Vol 2 is expected to hit the shelves in November. Newcastle softies NASENBLUTEN have their third release on the Industrial Strength label titled 'BRICK SHITHOUSE EP' (IS037). Sydney's 'Rage Reset' have had a repressing of their first record by PCD (PCP Germany) titled 'Syndrome EP', it contains 3 extra tracks.

Adelaides hardcore posse 'Killa Kanga Records' have released 2 EP's featuring Angu\$ (what's up?) and George the Boss among others.

Expect to see DJ Crisis on the CenCor label soon, 'Enolagay' by Brisbane live act Base X has been pressed on vinyi by German label Dancestreet, features a Ken Jensen mix as well as a remix by Germany's DJ Tom.

If you've got the balls....check out the latest tape by NASENBLUTEN titled N. of Terror. Contains all original material.

All the above are Australian so Fucking Support!!




