




DJ PROFILE the Ster

IRA HOW LONG DID IT TAKE YOU TO MASTER THE FINE ART OF BEATMIXING?

I don't think I ever pondered the thought of being a DJ, I just wanted to learn how to play the records I was buying. I mean yeah, I wanted to be a DJ but whether it waas at a friends birthday party or at a rave, I just wanted to play the music I loved.

JRA CAN YOU TELL THE READ-ERS HOW IT IS YOU ACHIEVE THAT FABULOUS DO OF YOURS, OR IS IT A FAMILY SECRET? (FASHION TIPS BY CHESTER).

Well, I get up around 4am walk into the bathroom turn on the hot water in the basin, put the plug in. Throw in a new cake of soap, then jump in the shower shampoo and condition my hair (Pert 2 in 1 to save time). After exiting the shower I blow dry my hair (I mean towel dry my hair). Now, the soap should have melted by now so when it is a soft, pulpy texture I run it through my hands, grab each strand and individually dread each lock of hair, after I apply all locks with soap I wait until the soap has dried. approx 35 minutes, then I apply more coats as the desired effect takes place. Remember the more coats the better the effect. (Note: try to avoid Dove Soap, the feathers aren't a trendy

Yes, Twelve Inches has survived to see another page, deep amongst the pages of Sydney's own 'rave' tabloid JRA This month a few tips on DJ'ing (if you happen to be into DJ'ing,) a look at some new releases (on a harder tip) and a quick rundown of party info that could interest you.

On the vinyl front, last issue we spoke of a new release from Newcastle based group Nasenbluten. Well it's here - 'Not as good as 100% No Soul' is what it's called and probably true. Although don't get me wrong it's what can be expected of this crude trio. Heaps of hip hop samples, raw breaks and ghastly samples make it a strong release. It sounds fresh, something I was hoping it would be. The last thing I wanted to hear was the same style as three years ago. No industry related payouts (except one small one aimed at record labels, in general of course) and twice as much humour as the first. Also on local releases Luke Kenny a.k.a. The Bezerker is set for another release on an overseas label. This time BZRK Black Label is giving us a taste of hardcore Australian style. It's release is a few months away but I'm told it's worth the wait. The Bezerker will also be featured on another Bastard Loud release through the ISR label in the not so distant future and hopefully also on a Sydney based label soon to be launched.

Just bought decks, your record collection is growing? Can't wait to taste the stardom,

wealth and the life of a 'rave' DJ!
Well don't get too excited, let me tell you
Dj'ing is not what it's made out to be even
though other publications believe it is the
career move of the 90's. Sure mixing is fun,
once you've got the hang of it, but once it
moves from your bedroom to the real world it
can become a nightmare.

In my terms vinyl should be classified as a hard drug. All you vinyl junkies out there know that. My only tip is this - make your addiction your own style. Be original don't play like your best friend. Create you're own style and stick to it. Sure cross over into other styles and as the music changes (and I guarantee it will) change with it. Take on other styles of that sound and create a name from there. No one wants another bland happyhard or nu-nrg DJ playing the same records for another hour. There are so many styles of teckno out there today that the choice is endless. Don't stare at the two words most DJ's stare at:

DEAD END.

On the party scene nothing much has happened since we last spoke. There are a few noticeable parties on there way. Hardcore Heaven 3 looks like the next big one (apart from Sanctuary which are yet to secure a date.) Ascension, Bass Control and Mayhem all lock into the 5th of April and in the not so distant future we see the return of the Prophecy, Nightbreed and of course Voyage 2.

By now you've probably heard any number of rumous regarding the postponement of SANC-TUARY. The Breakfast Club Crew want to set the record straight. We feel that you are entitled to a full explanation, and that's precisely what you are going to get, right here, right now....

Auburn / Council received Development Application (DA) seven weeks prior to our advertised date, Saturday March 8. During this seven week period we conducted follow up activities and kept in regular contact with the venue owner who

was conducting business with Auburn Council. We were assured that our application would be accepted and all details would be finalised by March 8.

On the morning of Friday March 7, after months of organisation, we began to receive deliveries and prepare the venue for SANCTUARY. We met with Flemington Police and they were very impressed with our professional approach and gave us their support. It was at this time that two representatives from Auburn Council arrived at the venue. One of these representatives specialises in fire safety and he informed us that our DA could not be finalised until alterations were made to the fire exit situation in the venue. We

were shocked that this announcement

had been left until the day prior to the event. There was no entering into the decision, as it stood the warehouse was a potential danger it it contained the amount of equipment and the number of

people we planned on.

We then had a tough decision to make. We could find an alternative venue, which would not be of the standard we desired, or we could postpone, until the DA was finalised. As you know we chose the latter and we stand by our

decision, we did not want to compromise the concept of our party in any way.

Since then we have been doing all we can to make the necessary alterations to the venue in order to make it safe, as well as spectac-

ular! We regret that at this stage we cannot confirm a date, all we can do is keep you informed, and thank you once again for your patience and your support.

If you've been out and about in the last month or so you may have heard Spellbound playing one or two of these tracks so if you've wondered why you can't find them anywhere it's because they just ain't out yet.
