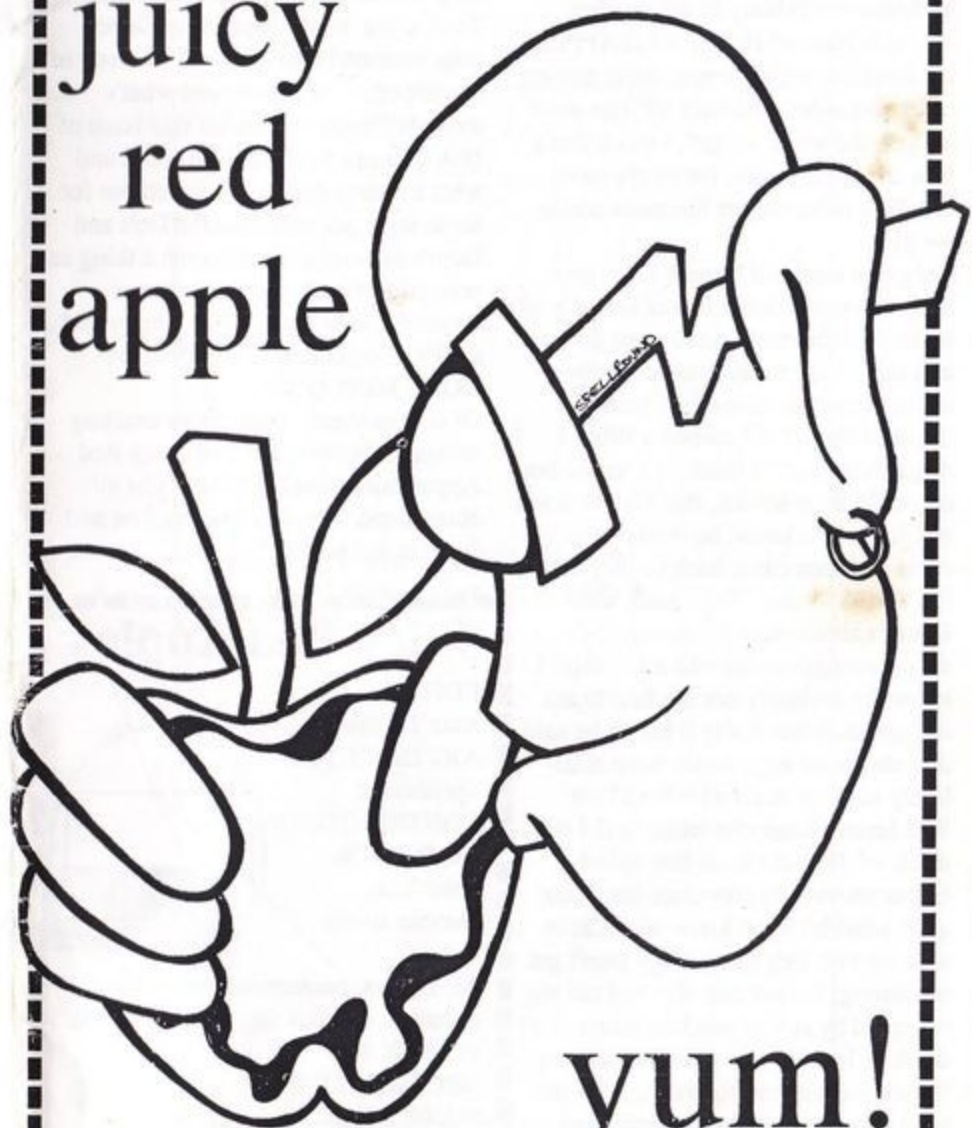

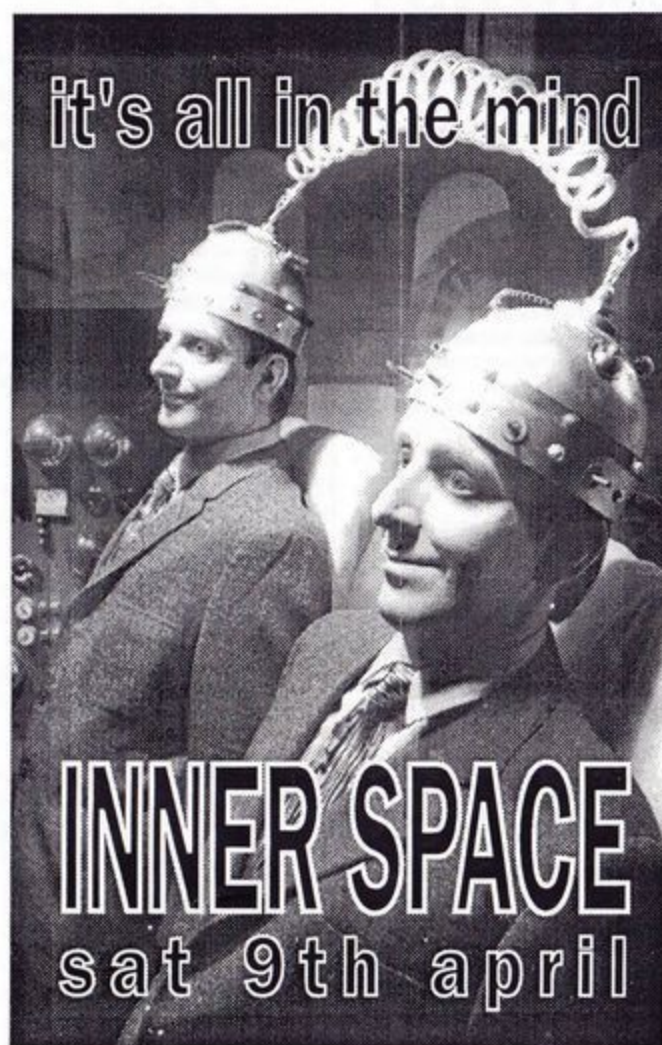

Of course there's many more exciting things in this here issue of Juicy Red Apple, but instead of telling you all about them why dont you read on and find out for yourself.....

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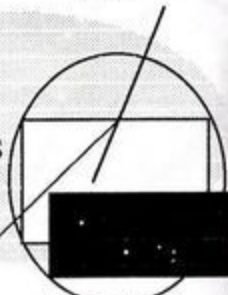
